

The Result of “International Cybersecurity Workshop, Exercise and Tour 2022”

On December 8-9, 2022, NISC hosted the International Cybersecurity Workshop, Exercise and Tour.

This event has been hosted by Japan every year since 2018.

In the workshop, participants discussed the efforts with regards to critical infrastructure protection and public-private partnerships in each country. In the Table-top Exercise, participants shared their practices on the public-private partnership and international cooperation, under the scenarios assuming the cyberattacks targeting on the satellite network systems utilized in each country.

And the participants toured the Industrial Cyber Security Center of Excellence (ICSCoE) operated by IPA, and also participated in the Cross-Sectoral Exercises for Critical Infrastructure Protection through the communication exercise assuming to be the Point of Contact (PoC) of each country.

Through this event, NISC expects to share the good practices for cybersecurity and strengthen our international relationship.

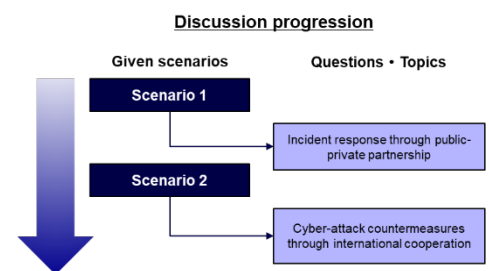
